- ❖ A national not-for-profit association motivating 50+ adults to lead a healthy lifestyle through the senior games movement.
- ❖ A multi-sport organizations council member of the United States Olympic Committee.
- ❖ The organization that governs the Summer National Senior Games. The NSGA also governs smaller multi-sport festivals and single sport championships.
- ❖ Owner of the largest multi-sport event in the world for 50+ seniors, the Summer National Senior Games.
  - 18 sports
  - 16 days
  - 12,750+ athletes projected for the 2009 Games
- ❖ Owner of the 2008 National Senior Games Championship Festival and Euflexxa Hockey Championships.
  - 5 Sports
  - 4 days
  - 1,500-2,000 athletes projected for 2008
- ❖ An umbrella for 51 member organizations across the United States and Europe that host State Senior Games competitions. NSGA supports and sanctions these member state organizations so that approximately 300,000 adults can participate in events year-round that will keep them motivated and lead to a better quality life as they age.
